MINUTES
OPEN SESSION

Chairman Blumberg convened the meeting at 9:36 a.m.

- The minutes from the June 13, 2018 open session were reviewed and approved as submitted.
- Attorneys representing the plaintiffs in the juvenile lifer lawsuit reviewed files on June 22, 2018 as part of the discovery process.
- Chairman Blumberg and Commissioner Miller spoke at the State's Attorneys Conference on June 18, 2018 about the Justice Reinvestment Act (JRA) and the parole process.
- The Maryland State Police no longer assists with inmate transportation for extradition or to detainees. Chairman Blumberg met with Division of Correction (DOC) and Division of Parole and Probation (DPP) administrators to discuss ways to resolve the issue.
- Offenders should be told on the record that if the decision is a continuance on supervision and a detainer is found to be lodged against them that they will not be continued to the street but to that detainer.
- Commissioners should check the schedule frequently for changes.
- At 10:08 a.m. under General Provisions Art. § 3-305 Chairman Blumberg made a motion to end the open session and go into a closed session to discuss personnel matters, review cases en-banc and to consult with legal counsel. A vote was taken and all commissioners were in favor. The meeting will reconvene in the Parole Commission's conference room.
