The totals on the Sex Distribution table represent the manual total population on the date the report is prepared. Differences between categories are due to missing data on the automated system. Information for an additional 252 inmates housed in local jails, Pre-trial and P&P Home Detention and MCAC Federal contract is not available.

As of April 2007, race categories on the report are consistent with OBSCIS I modifications and reflect federal NCIC race codes. The inclusion of Asian and Unknown categories on the report has resulted in a small change in category percentages.
