Board Meeting was held at: The Community Building, 100 Community Place, Crownsville, MD 21032

Board meeting commenced at 6:00pm.

Present for the board was: Robert Wilson – Chairman, John Michel – Vice Chairman, Jacques Cowan and Carol Loveless. Bryan Fischer was absent.

Present for DPSCS was: Stevi Ambrose – Administrator and James Pasko – Assistant Attorney General.

Present for the MSP was: Capt. Andy Johnson, Lt. Padric Lacy, F/Sgt. Donald Pickle, F/Sgt. Pat McCrory, Sr/Tpr. Brett Lazuick, and Sr/Tpr. Joshua Taylor.

- 1) The Minutes to the meeting for August 21, 2018 were approved by the Board and read into the record.
- 2) A hearing was held for applicant **438-98145**. By a vote of 4 to 0, the board **OVERTURNS** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a non-restricted permit except where prohibited by law.
- 3) A hearing was held for applicant **438-95010**. By a vote of 4 to 0, the board **OVERTURNS** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a non-restricted permit except where prohibited by law.
- 4) A hearing was held for applicant **438-76949-A**. By a vote of 4 to 0, the board **OVERTURNS** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a non-restricted permit except where prohibited by law.
- 5) A hearing was held for applicant **438-97832**. By a vote of 4 to 0, the board **OVERTURNS** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a non-restricted permit except where prohibited by law.
- 6) A hearing was held for applicant **438-98050**. During the hearing **a motion to close the meeting was made by R. Wilson, seconded by J. Cowan, and approved by J. Michel, and C. Loveless. The meeting was closed in pursuant to section 3-305b(13) of the GENERAL PROVISIONS code.** By a vote of 4 to 0, the board **OVERTURNS** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a non-restricted permit except where prohibited by law. **There being no other business to be discussed on this case in a closed session a motion to return to a public session was made by J. Cowan, seconded by R. Wilson, and approved by J. Michel and C. Loveless.**
- 7) The applicant **438-96124** was a failure to appear. Therefore the original decision of the MSP is **SUSTAINED**.

- 8) A hearing was held for applicant **438-97166**. By a vote of 4 to 0, the board **MODIFIES** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a non-restricted permit except where prohibited by law.
- 9) A hearing was held for applicant **438-97126-A**. By a vote of 4 to 0, the board **MODIFIES** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a non-restricted permit except where prohibited by law.
- 10) A hearing was held for applicant **438-81216-A**. By a vote of 4 to 0, the board **MODIFIES** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a non-restricted permit except where prohibited by law.
- 11) A hearing was held for applicant **438-83618**. By a vote of 3 to 0, with 1 abstaining, the board **MODIFIES** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a non-restricted permit except where prohibited by law.
- 12) A hearing was held for applicant **438-71519**. By a vote of 4 to 0, the board **MODIFIES** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a permit tailored to the applicant's good and substantial reason.
- 13) **A motion to close meeting was made by R. Wilson, seconded by J. Cowan, and approved by J. Michel, and C. Loveless. The meeting was closed to hear case numbers 438-97994, 438-93173-A and 438-97851.**

- 14) A hearing was held for applicant **438-97994**. By a vote of 3 to 0, with 1 abstaining, the board **MODIFIES** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a non-restricted permit except where prohibited by law.
- 15) A hearing was held for applicant **438-93173-A**. By a vote of 4 to 0, the board **MODIFIES** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a non-restricted permit except where prohibited by law.
- 16) A hearing was held for applicant **438-97851**. By a vote of 4 to 0, the board **MODIFIES** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a non-restricted permit except where prohibited by law.
- 17) The Board remained in closed session to discuss procedure for the evenings scheduled reviews.
- 18) **There being no other business to be discussed in a closed session a motion to return to a public session was made by J. Cowan, seconded by C. Loveless, and approved by R. Wilson and J. Michel.**
- 19) The applicant **438-97302** was unable to appear and requested a review be held in their absence. The Board ruled that the applicant failed to provide proper notification, therefore the appeal would be treated as a Failure to Appear and the original decision of the MSP is **SUSTAINED**.
- 20) A review was held for applicant **438-97512**. By a vote of 4 to 0, the board **SUSTAINS** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP.

- 21) **There being no other business a motion to adjourn was made at 10:20pm by R. Wilson, seconded by J. Cowan, and approved by J. Michel and C. Loveless.**
