- 2) A hearing was held for applicant **438-92123**. By a vote of 3 to 0, the board **REVERSES** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a non-restricted permit except where prohibited by law.

- 5) A hearing was held for applicant **438-98857**. By a vote of 3 to 0, the board **SUSTAINS** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP.
- 6) A hearing was held for applicant **438-98669**. By a vote of 3 to 0, the board **REVERSES** the decision of the Secretary of the MSP and orders the issuance of a non-restricted permit except where prohibited by law.
